Subject – Bulk finalization of provisional Bills of Entry with loading value in the System – reg.

Kind reference is invited to ICES advisory 45/2025 dated 24/07/2025 wherein facility to bulk finalize Bills of entry with zero loading has been operationalized.

2. In this regard, system has now been enhanced to enable bulk finalization of provisional bills of entry **with loading percentage value is greater than zero**. This is particularly relevant for SVB cases or any other wherein **uniform percentage-based loading is to be applied in valuation**.

3. The officer using the **FAO role** has to enter IEC of the importer and supplier name. The system will auto-populate all the provisional Bills of entry pending for finalization for that importer and respective supplier. The officer with FAO role must then enter loading value in the system. In case of duty increase, after finalization, system will generate differential challan and will be forwarded to ICEGATE for payment by the importer. The bill of entry wise challans details may be checked by the officer, if required.

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3. The officer having FDC role cannot modify loading value and has option to approve the provisional bills of entry for finalization or partially approve the provisional bills of entry by deselecting the bills of entry from the list or send back to FAO.

4. The officer can view the new challan details for each Bill of entry by clicking on “duty” tab.

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
